In **Science** we will learn about **Light /Living things.**

History—we will be finding out about— The Ancient Kingdom of Benin.

In **PE** we will be working with

Mrs Luker on developing their athletics /Hockey/Net skills. Pupil will continue to apply and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different ways and to link them to make actions and sequences of movement.

In **English** we will explore writings of significant British writer—William Shakespeare—learning about the specific period/audience/purpose of some of his writing looking specifically at Macbeth. Pupils will also be exposed to different reading and writing forms to develop their pleasure for reading in addition comprehension skills.
