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Clubs

For a long time St Peter's have offered clubs either free of charge or heavily subsidised. We have liaised with other Southwark and Lewisham schools and we are one of the few remaining schools to offer such an incentive. We value our after school activity clubs and do want to continue to offer them to your children. All clubs from December are fee paying. If your child attends brass club you will receive a separate letter informing you of the changes. If your child attends a club but the school has not received payment for two weeks, we will offer the space to another child on the waiting list. You will still be charged for the weeks your child has attended. For more information please see the office. It is expected that once your child starts a club they will remain in the club for the duration of the club, usually one term. If you have a reason why your child can no longer attend a club please see the office as the place can be offered to another child on the waiting list.

Spanish and Foreign Languages at St Peter's

The teaching of a foreign language is statutory from Key Stage 2. At St Peter's for a number of years we have invested in teaching our children another language from a younger age. We have researched the teaching of foreign languages in other schools across the borough and many schools use their own internal expertise. We will now use our own teachers to teach French in Year 3 and 4. Early Years and Key Stage 1 will be taught Spanish by their teachers. This means we will no longer be employing an additional teacher for Spanish. Year 5 and Year 6 will continue to have Latin.

Spanish Club: We aim to continue Spanish Club; **however the club will not run this Monday.** We hope to continue the club the following Monday with the use of a parent volunteer and supported by a HLTA. If you can speak Spanish and wish to assist please do come and let the office staff know and I will meet you to discuss this further. Thank you to Maddox's mum in Year 3 who has already volunteered.

After School Club and Breakfast Clubs

Full time places for After School Club will rise by £5 to £45 per week from January 2018.

Breakfast Club will rise to £3 per day from January 2018.

Please note if you are asking for a full time place you will be still charged for the week even if your child does not attend for the full week. The school still have to keep the place open for your child and pay staff costs and resources for the club even if your child does not attend.
